



Sexual health services for people living in Greenwich are changing from 1st Oct 2016

The Trafalgar Clinic at Queen Elizabeth Hospital will become a specialist service. If you need an appointment, you will be referred by your GP or one of our local GSH Clinics.

To make it easier to access sexual health and contraception services, there will be longer opening times at the Market Street Clinic (GSH Central) in Woolwich, including evenings and Saturdays.

There are a number of ways you can test for sexually transmitted infections (STIs), including HIV. These include:
